Leveraging his talents and celebrity connections to orchestrate a spectacular one-man publicity campaign, he mobilized pressure on the Roosevelt administration for an Allied plan to rescue Europe ' s Jews. Then after the war, Hecht became notorious, embracing the labels “ gangster ” and “ terrorist ” in partnering with the mobster Mickey Cohen to smuggle weapons to Palestine in the fight for a Jewish state. *The Notorious Ben Hecht: Iconoclastic Writer and Militant Zionist* is a biography of a great twentieth-century writer that treats his activism during the 1940s as the central drama of his life.
